## Course

- The Herron Park cyclocross course is a 1.5-2 mile loop, comprised of a mix of fast double-track roads and grass/dirt with both human made and artificial barriers.
- The registration, start & finish area will be located near the pavilion across to the northeast of the main parking area.
- Herron is a bikers' gateway to the vast Foys to Blacktail trail system through timberlands extending south toward Blacktail Mountain. Support your local trail advocates.

## Directions

- Herron Park is located in the Flathead Valley west of Kalispell, most easily accessed via the Foys Lake exit/roundabout off the Highway 93 Bypass and following Foys Lake Road to the west until reaching Herron Park, 2310 Foys Lake Rd, Kalispell, MT 59901.
- The Flathead area includes Whitefish, Kalispell, Columbia Falls, Bigfork and other full service communities with lodging and restaurants a short distance away. Please no parking along Foys Lake Road. This weekend is also Oktoberfest Celebration in Whitefish.

- Flathead Cycling will cover USAC one-day registration for Cat 5 and Junior riders.

- Cycling helmets are mandatory for all competitors.
- Dogs on Leashes.
- Be respectful of non-racer park users at Herron Park, normal park rules apply.
- There is no overnight camping available at Herron Park.
- Stay on Designated Trails and Marked Routes.

- Keep a clean bike, help prevent the spread of noxious weeds.
